

## **Questions Builder Wheel: How To**

**How to rotate the wheel:** To rotate the individual wheel pieces, click on one segment. Each click will rotate that part of the wheel a tiny bit (approx. 15 degrees).

**Up and Down Arrows:** By clicking on the up or down arrow buttons, you can change how the wheel rotates when you click on it. Up (clockwise). Down (counterclockwise).

**Making a correct question:** Align segments of the three wheel parts with the red outline in order to help students create a grammatically correct question.

**The Colors:** The colors for the middle and inner wheels indicate grammatically correct sentence options. Blue goes with blue. Yellow goes with yellow.

**'Will' and 'Did':** The words 'will' and 'did' are both yellow and blue. They can be used with either word color.

**'I':** The word "I" is a bit special and has a blue star with it. It can be used with some words from blue and yellow. These words being: was, did, and do, will.

**Randomize:** Click on the randomize button to randomize the orientation of the wheel. You might wonder why you might want to randomize the wheel. Here are a couple ideas you might be able to use:

1. Click on the randomize button. If the orientation is off, realign the segments that are off accordingly. Now, the student(s) should make a question using this question.
2. If you do part 1 and the aligned segments are incorrect, ask your students to help you fix it to make it correct.

You could combine these options together to make a game based around the wheel.
